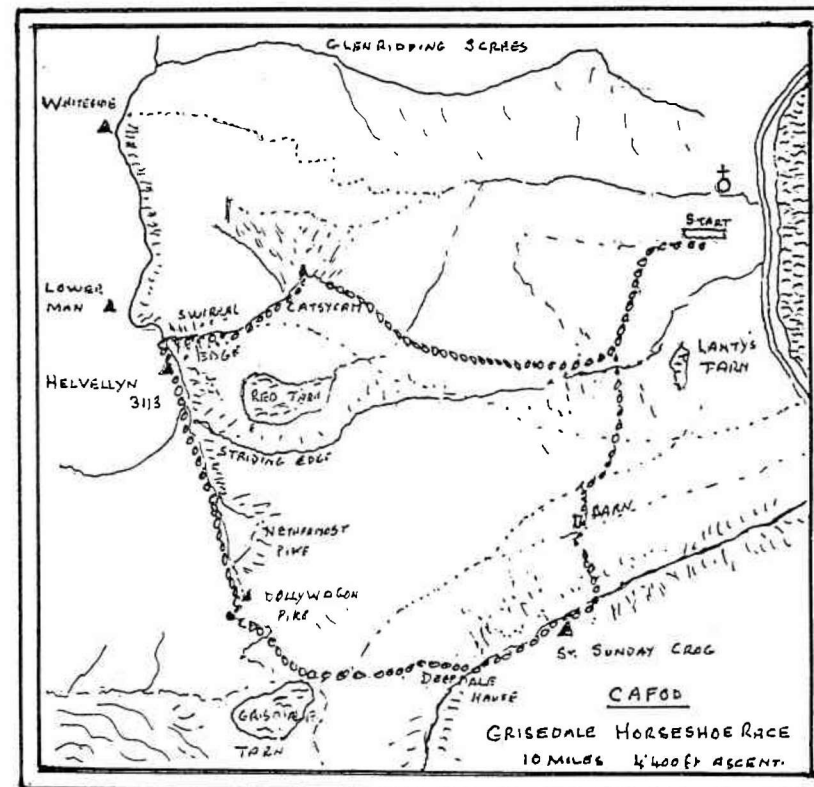
Dunmail. The generator is now installed in its own housing at the rear of the hut and is in use. Let there be light!
